

Healthcare content startup Sepalika raises \$750K from Accel Partners

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Sepalika, a healthcare content platform that offers research-based information on diet, lifestyle changes and supplements, has raised \$750,000 (Rs 4.8 crore) in seed funding led by venture capital firm Accel Partners.

The firm, owned and operated by Moonjur Healthcare Pvt Ltd., will use the capital to further enhance its platform and strengthen its core proposition.

Sepalika offers expert content for consumers and healthcare providers on the science of using supplements to boost immunity, attain better health and counter the side effects of drugs. It attempts to help people reduce or reverse chronic health conditions through guidance on lifestyle, dietary supplements and exercise.

Currently, the startup focuses on 11 chronic health conditions, including Type 2 diabetes, cardiac diseases, arthritis, mental health and depression, Alzheimer's, and more.

The company was founded in 2016 by Sharda Agarwal and Mahesh Jayaraman.
