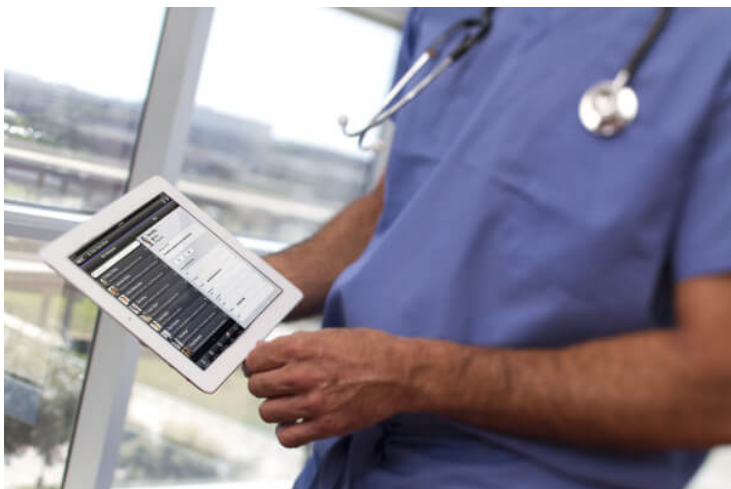


TGIF 2018 witnesses the launch of cancer care tech platform
