

Lupin gets EDQM nod for its Mandideep facility

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Drug firm Lupin has said that it has received attestation from European Directorate for the Quality of Medicines (EDQM) for its Mandideep facility in Madhya Pradesh. The unit was inspected by EDQM in March this year.
