

Dr Sanjay Desai to receive Dr B C Roy Award

Leading orthopaedic surgeon and super specialist Dr Sanjay Desai has been nominated to receive the prestigious Dr. Bidhan Chandra Roy National Award that recognises the best talents in development of specialties in different branches in medicine. The award will be presented to Dr Desai by the President of India Ramnath Kovind in New Delhi.

The award was bestowed upon Dr Desai for his noteworthy work done in the orthopaedic field and for developing a subspecialty and taking it to an international level. Dr. B. C. Roy Award was instituted in 1962 in memory of Dr Bidhan Chandra Roy by Medical Council of India and is the highest medical honour of India.

Dr Desai, who is a Super Specialist in shoulder and knee Arthroscopic Surgery at Bhatia Hospital in Mumbai, is considered a pioneer in shoulder and knee surgeries in India. Dr Desai holds a brilliant academic record throughout his orthopaedic career

having won several laurels including a Gold Medal at the University of Liverpool, United Kingdom, scoring a second position in MS (Ortho), University of Bombay and winning the Khazanifar medal in MCh (Orth), University of Liverpool.

He is the recipient of several international awards like the 'Young achievers Award – 2002' conferred by the Indo-American society and Giants International Award in the field of medicine -- 2016. He has been Referee of the prestigious Journal of Bone & Joint Surgery, American Journal of Sports Medicine and is on the editorial board of the European Journal of Orthopaedic Surgery and Traumatology.
