

Rainbow Children's Hospital launches Video Consultations

With the coronavirus scare making it difficult for people to visit clinics and hospitals, teleconsultations are emerging as a viable alternative

With strict restrictions on movement and safety concerns forcing people to stay at home, patients needing medical care are also finding it hard to access a doctor. In an attempt to address these concerns, Rainbow Children's Hospital & BirthRight by Rainbow has thrown open video consultation facilities to help women and children seek medical advice for Gynecological and Pediatric issues from the safety of their homes.

The Hospital Group is ensuring that doctors are available for patients at the click of a button. And from 1st March to till now they have done 80 deliveries in their hospital.

The development comes a few days after the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare issued guidelines on the practice of telemedicine, giving much-needed statutory cover to health practitioners offering remote care in India.
