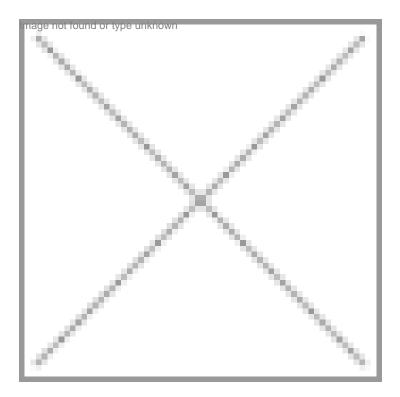


GE Healthcare bags FICCI Healthcare Excellence Award
