After the successful completion of its first batch, Bombay College of Pharmacy has announced the second batch of its live and Interactive online 'Data Analytics in Healthcare' course for the working healthcare professionals and pharmacy students from January 10, 2021. The curriculum of the three months, eight hours a week (96 hours) certificate course is designed by a leading analytics firm in the Pharma Industry - Navigo Analytix LLP.

"The course has been aimed to meet the growing demand for healthcare data scientists in the country," said Dr Krishnapriya Mohanraj, I/c Principal, Bombay College of Pharmacy.
