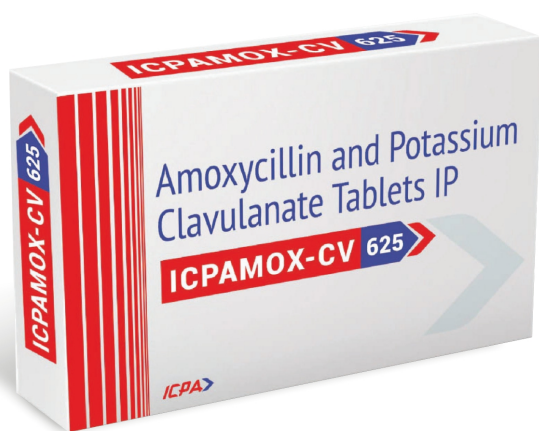


ICPA Health launches antibiotic to treat odontogenic infections
