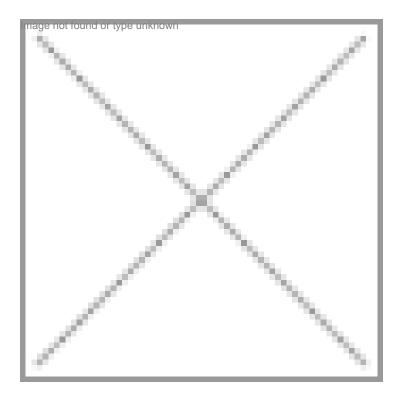




We are very confident to recover in the second half of 2009," said Venugopalan, president, Waters India. The company is an HPLC leader and holds 35-40 percent market share in this segment and almost 20
