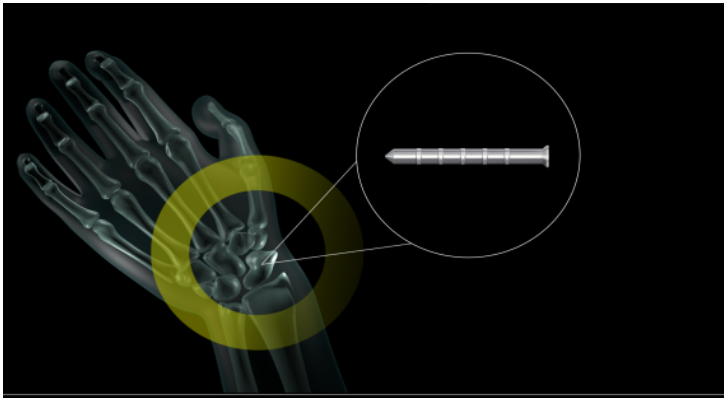


## Era of magnesium for orthopaedics and traumatology begins in India
