Surgeons from neighbouring states were familiarised with the latest techniques in treating bladder cancer

There were dedicated sessions on robotic-assisted neobladder surgery and robotic-assisted anastomosis, as well.

The main objective of this conference was to share the latest techniques in the treatment of bladder cancer and to enhance the adoption of new medical technologies including robotic-assisted surgery in Punjab and nearby states.
