

Bharat Biotech donates 2,00,000 doses of COVAXIN? to Republic of Vietnam

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COVAXIN? has received EUL in Vietnam



The Republic of Vietnam will receive 2,00,000 doses of Bharat Biotech COVAXIN?. Suchitra Ella, Joint MD, Bharat Biotech revealed this at a function hosted by Vuong Dinh Hue, President of the National Assembly of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam in the presence of distinguished dignitaries in New Delhi.

The donation represents a gesture of goodwill to provide access to Bharat Biotech WHO approved, indigenously developed COVAXIN? to fight the COVID-19 Pandemic across borders. COVAXIN? has received EUL in Vietnam.

Bharat Biotech was invited by the Embassy of Vietnam for a one-on-one meeting with the President of the National Assembly, to discuss avenues of cooperation, supplies, and technology transfer possibilities.

Bharat Biotech has completed Phase-2 and Phase-3 trials of COVAXIN? for children in the age group two to 18 years. The data has been submitted to the Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation (CDSCO) and the final approval is awaited. On approval, children will also have access to COVAXIN?.

In Vietnam, Bharat Biotech has been working with Duc Minh Medical JSC, towards the commercialisation of INDIRAB (Inactivated Rabies Vaccine). Duc Minh is Bharat Biotech's local partner in Vietnam.

Bharat Biotech has also supplied INDIRAB? to the Republic Nation supporting their national rabies vaccine requirement.
