Bengaluru's Kalyan Nagar and Whitefield are the latest additions



Indira IVF added two new centres in Bengaluru's Kalyan Nagar and Whitefield locations, increasing its presence to 104 hospitals in India. The organisation is also present in JP Nagar, Rajaji Nagar and Indira Nagar, and operates in a hub-and-spoke model to provide ease of access to its patients across the city.
