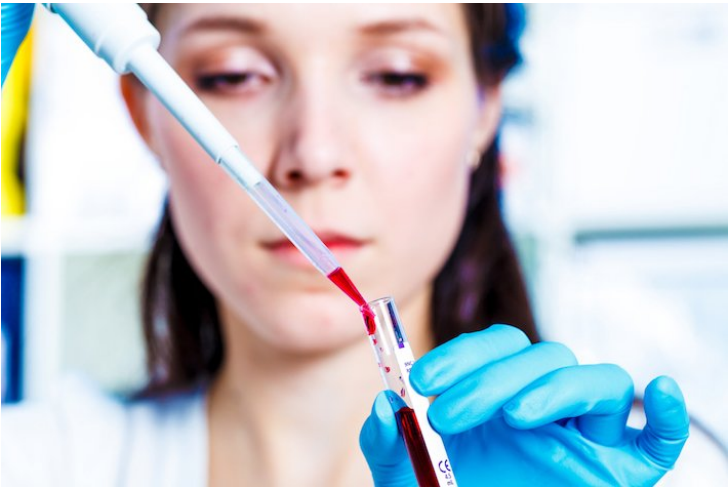


Neuberg Diagnostics unveils advanced Oncopathology reference lab in Mumbai
