Equipped with state-of-the-art interventional pulmonology technologies-including high-precision bronchoscopy, cryotherapy, endobronchial ultrasound (EBUS)-guided biopsies, and airway stenting-the clinic also offers personalised pulmonary rehabilitation, oxygen therapy, and lifestyle support programs tailored to each patient's needs.
