Together with our expanded infrastructure, modular operation theatres and critical care capacity, these capabilities will enable us to deliver more specialised and complex treatments under one integrated healthcare ecosystem."

The new facility adds 9 advanced modular operation theatres and more than 110 ICU beds to Regency Health Kanpur's existing infrastructure. The overall healthcare complex will now have a combined capacity of 775 beds, 18 advanced modular operation theatres and more than 200 ICU beds. Spread across three towers, the integrated healthcare complex spans approximately 8 lakh sq. ft.
