


Kakinada to have a bio-diesel plant

Naturol Bio-Energy will set up a 300 TPD integrated bio-diesel plant in Kakinada Special Economic Zone (KSEZ). The plant will be set up at an estimated cost of Rs 139.50 crore by Naturol Bio-Energy India in a JV with Energea GmbH, Austria.
