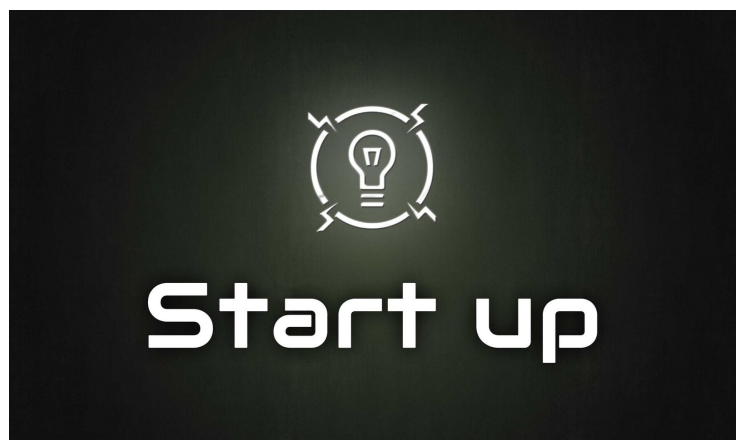

IIT Delhi
