Candidates who have completed the first degree from a recognized institution (where programmes are taught in English) are normally regarded as demonstrating the required English proficiency.

Fees Payable: Application Fee: S\$321.00; Tuition Fee: S\$25,680.00

Duration: Full-time: 12-months divided into three terms. Two modules per term for two terms and a dissertation in the third term.

Grant: MDIS is providing a special rebate of S\$1284 to Indian students applying this year. Additionally, under the '2014 International Student Tuition Grant', MDIS is providing a grant of S\$2000, for all students applying before 30th June.

Please note that (a) students who are awarded MDIS' Merit Scholarship will not be eligible for the 2014 International Student

Tuition Grant and (b) students who are entitled for this 2014 International Student Tuition Grant have to be in class by 31st December 2014.

- Postgraduate Diploma on the successful completion of 4 modules (equivalent to a total of 120 credits)
