He elaborated further saying, "Recently under RISHI, support was provided to Tezpur University, Assam; Gujarat Science City, Gujarat; GB Pant Institute of Himalayan Environment & Development, Almora, Uttarakhand and Pushpa Gurjaral Science City, Kapurthala, Punjab.

The S&T minister stated that National Innovation Foundation- India (NIF), an autonomous body of the Department of Science and Technology also organizes an annual national level competition of students' ideas and innovations called IGNITE where school students up to class 12th and school drop-outs up to the age of 17 years can participate.
