

AP signs MoU with AP BioNet

The Government of Andhra Pradesh and Asia-Pacific Bioinformatics Network (APBioNet) have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) at Singapore. The MoU will enable the Life Sciences Research Institutions in Andhra Pradesh, such as, CCMB, CDFD, IICT, NIN etc. to be a part of the Global Research Network, which has a focus on Bioinformatics.
