

Cabinet approves agreement between India and Belarus

The Union Cabinet chaired by the Prime Minister has been apprised of the Agreement between the Indian National Science Academy (INSA) and the National Academy of Sciences of Belarus (NASB) on Scientific and Technological Cooperation for mutual benefit in the areas of science, technology, agriculture, etc.

The Agreement is aimed at identifying, assessing, developing and commercializing globally competitive technologies from India and Belarus.
